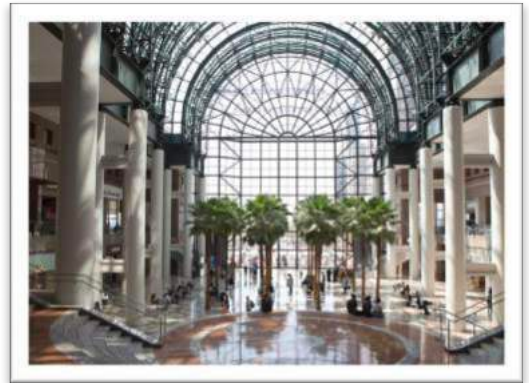

Since opening in 2009, the High Line has become an icon of contemporary landscape architecture.
